You are invited to submit your research papers addressing international accounting research topics for the 2027 International Accounting Section Midyear Meeting in Norfolk, VA at Old Dominion University on January 7-9, 2027. We also encourage you to volunteer to serve as a reviewer, discussant, and/or a moderator.

Practitioners and academics renowned worldwide will serve as our luncheon and plenary featured speakers. We also offer plenty of opportunities to network with colleagues, providing a warm and hospitable community to our members and guests.

We welcome papers on a wide variety of topics and methodologies, *with a particular focus on global contexts and environments*, including:

- Financial Reporting, Disclosure, and Standards
 - Financial reporting and disclosure
 - Accounting standards and regulatory changes
 - Sustainability and ESG reporting practices
- Audit and Taxation
 - Auditing and assurance
 - Tax policy and practice across jurisdictions
- Management and Governance
 - Management and internal control issues
 - Corporate governance and its interaction with financial reporting, disclosure, and auditing
- Methods and Emerging Research Tools
 - Application of textual analysis, artificial intelligence (AI), and data analytics in accounting research
- Education and Practice-Oriented Research
 - Accounting education research and instructional case studies
- Broader and Cross-Cutting Topics
 - Other topics in international accounting
- Single-country studies (including U.S.-focused) that: Single-country studies (including those focused on the U.S.) that address emerging issues, utilize novel data sources or methodologies, or offer insights relevant to standard setters, regulators, and international businesses.

We also welcome proposals for panel sessions. For panel proposals, please describe the rationale and importance of the topic in a page or so, indicate the planned panelists, and whether you need any help from the International Accounting Section to contact the panelists. Unless otherwise stated, it will be assumed that the person submitting the panel proposal would be willing to moderate the panel. The deadline for submissions for both research papers and panel proposals is September 1, 2026 at 11:59 pm ET.

NOTE: All submissions will be subject to a blind review process. Therefore, submitted documents should NOT include a title page or any author identifying information.

Submitting authors will be asked to copy/paste an abstract of the paper into a form field, separately from the submitted document. Authors will be listed in the printed program in the order they are entered during the online submission process. PDF is the preferred format for paper submissions.
